6. In case of joint holders attending the AGM, the Member whose name appears as the first holder in the order of names as per the Register of Members of the Company will be entitles to vote.

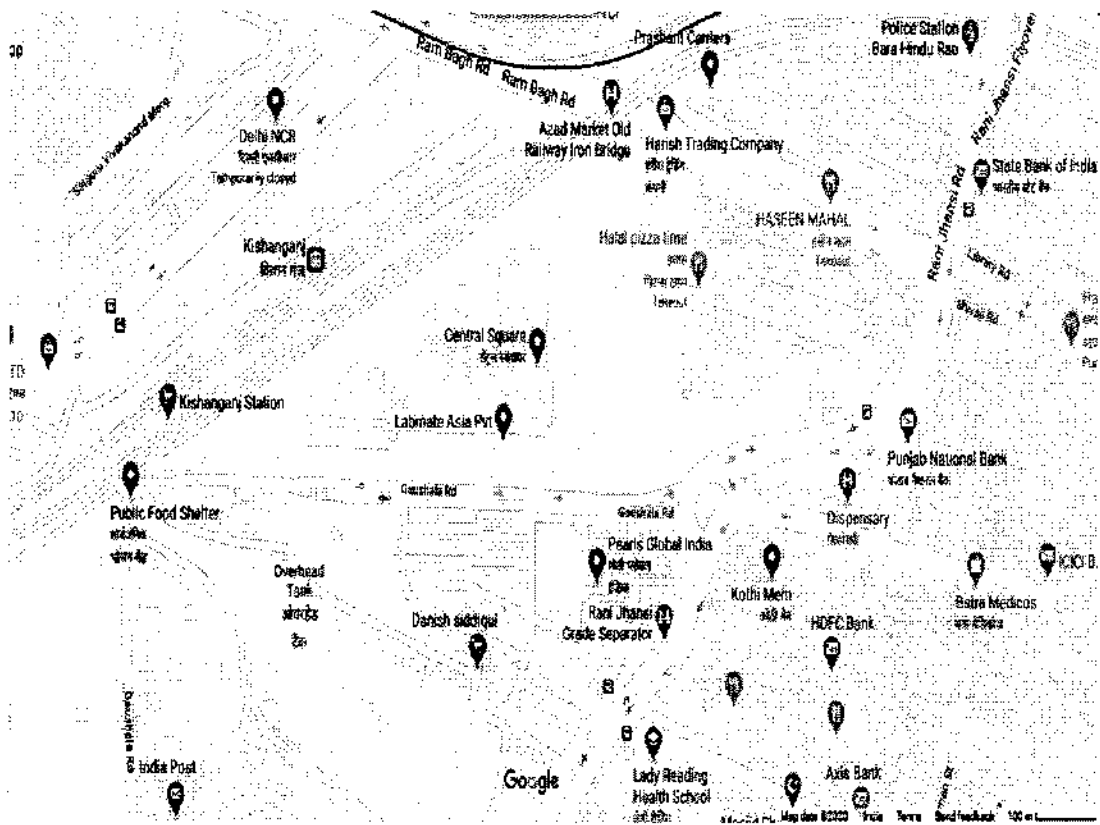

Your Directors have pleasure in presenting this 24th Annual Report together with the Audited Financial Statements of your Company for the year ended March 31, 2020.

COMPANY'S AFFAIRS

The main object of the Company inter-alia provides to carry on the business of ginners, weavers, spinners, dyers, manufactures, importers, exporters in all kinds of yarns, cloth etc.

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

During the year, the Company has earned income from interest on deposits with banks of Rs. 20,319/- (Rs. Twenty Thousand Three Hundred and Nineteen only). The loss before tax of the Company for the current financial year is Rs. 12,610/- (Rs. Twelve Thousand Six Hundred and Ten only), and after taking into account income tax of Rs. 5,202/- (Rs. Five Thousand Two Hundred and Two only), the net loss for the current Financial Year is Rs. 17,812/- (Rs. Seventeen Thousand Eight Hundred and Twelve only).

Risk management framework

The Company's board of directors has overall responsibility for the establishment and oversight of the Company's risk management which includes to identify, analyse and monitor the risks faced by the Company.

(i) Credit risk

Credit risk is the risk of financial loss to the Company if a customer or counterparty to a financial instrument fails to meet its contractual obligations, and arises principally from the Company's receivables from customers. Credit risk on cash and cash equivalents as mentioned above is limited as the Company generally invests in deposits with banks with high credit ratings assigned by domestic credit rating agencies.

(ii) Liquidity risk

Liquidity risk is the risk that the Company will encounter difficulty in meeting the obligations associated with its financial liabilities that are settled by delivering cash or another financial asset. The Company's approach to managing liquidity is to ensure, as far as possible, that it will have sufficient liquidity to meet its liabilities when they are fallen due, under both normal and stressed conditions, without incurring unacceptable losses or risking damage to the Company's reputation. The Company believes that its liquidity position, including total cash and cash equivalent of ₹ 5,93,414/- as at 31st March, 2020 (31st March, 2019 ₹ 6,13,984/-), anticipated future internally generated funds from operations will enable it to meet its future known obligations in the ordinary course of business.

C. Capital management

The Company manages its capital to ensure that it will continue as going concern while maximising the return to stakeholders through the optimisation of the debt and equity balance.








